DESCRIPTION

A significant, historic ranch has been family owned and operated as a cattle and hunting property for over 50± years. The Treaty Stone Ranch is the site of the famous Texas Treaty Stone, identifying the location of the Treaty of Peace made between John H. Rollins, Special Agent of the United States Government, and the various Chiefs of all of the Indian Tribes of Texas on December 10, 1850. The ranch functions as a great livestock and wildlife ranch, with minimal improvements offering the opportunity to build to your needs.

IMPROVEMENTS

There is an old rock house plus 2 home sites with full utilities providing infrastructure for future improvements. Complete low perimeter fencing; 3.9± miles of recent fencing.

WATER

An impressive 2,600± feet of both sides of live water Wallace Creek includes over one-half mile of the refreshing headwaters of Wallace Creek lined with seasonal fresh watercress. A natural spring feeds one of the tanks near the rock home. Fully stocked 3-acre lake. Conservation lake and dam creating a 14± acre seasonal reservoir. 8 year-around stock tanks, and 4 above ground cement or metal reservoirs. There are 3 working windmills plus 2 sub pumps and 1 shared sub pump. All wells are believed to be in the Hickory Sand Aquifer.



VEGETATION/TERRAIN

Kleingrass pastures and rolling native rangeland combines with portions of rugged landscape. There are scenic views with magnificent 50'-70' bluffs and rock outcroppings, with elevations ranging from 1.420-1.600'± asl. Grand trees include large Live Oaks, Cedar Elm, Pecan, Mesquite and other native to the area. Persimmon, Cat Claw, Bee Bush, and Algerita are a variety of brush coverage that makes an excellent wildlife habitat.

The perfect environment supports native white-tailed deer, turkey, dove, quail, hogs and others, plus there are fishing
