- Original family homestead from 1891
- Ranch history includes:
  - Operational cattle ranch
  - Timber harvesting
  - Christmas tree harvesting
  - Raising small game (pigs, emus, chickens, etc)
  - Crop production

- 120 acres of tillable land
- Land would support up to 50 head +/- of cattle

# Special Features

- End of maintained county road
- Large portions of property bordered by BLM and DNR land (these lands are isolated and not accessible to public)

- Canada can be seen from higher elevations of property
- Very private and isolated due to road, surrounding terrain, and ownership of adjacent parcels
- Nearly a square mile, even more when adjacent public land is included for use
- Potential Lease of BLM land for cattle











## Home Facts

- Ranch style home built in 1967
- 3 main floor bedrooms
- 2 bathrooms
- Unfinished walkout basement
- Unparalleled views from almost every room of the house
- Generous kitchen with passthrough to dining room
- Eat in kitchen space with door to back deck
- Large living room fireplace
- Fireplace built by hand cut stone from local quarry
- Walls are constructed with solid, laminated 2x4's with no stud spacing in between
- Main floor windows are newer with double pane vinyl framed windows and basement has original aluminum framed windows
- Birch hard wood flooring throughout main floor
- Furnace is dual fuel with wood burning and electric forced air
- Water rights for gravity fed spring
  - No electricity necessary
  - Pressure comes from gravity flow from the fall from the mouth of the spring approximately 300 ft
  - Spring is fed directly out of the mountain via a cistern and plumbing
  - Water pressure has not varied and is enough for household use, gardens, and animals
