Access


Access is directly off State Highway 20. There is no public or private access through the property. The elevation is 4,000 feet.





Infrastructure Improvements










Wildlife

Many smaller species of wildlife call the Pecos Bosque Ranch home. Turkey are also very common as are many other species of birds. The owners control the hunting and have hunted it very conservatively.






