NOW THEREFORE THIS DEED WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), cash in hand paid and other good and valuable consideration deemed valid in law, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor and Party of the First Part do hereby grant, give and convey, with covenants of general warranty, unto the Grantee and Party of the Second Part, as joint tenants with right of survivorship, i.e., in the event of the death of either grantee fee simple title to the whole or the hereinafter described real estate shall forthwith vest in survivors or survivor together with all rights, rights of way, improvements and appurtenances thereunto belonging all of their right, title, and interest, together with all rights, rights of way, improvements and appurtenances thereunto belonging, all that certain tract or parcel of real estate containing 4 1/2 acres more or less, situate on Piney Mountain near the Black Lick School, in Romney District, Hampshire County, West Virginia, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:
